tiny-k Early Intervention, serving Douglas County, invites you to bring your child to a **FREE** screening clinic for infants and toddlers (birth to 3rd birthday). The purpose of these screenings is to see how your child is developing. If you have questions or concerns about your child's walking, talking, seeing, hearing, or learning, this screening will provide information.

Your child will be screened by child development professionals who will look at your child's:

- gross motor skills (such as walking and sitting)
- fine motor skills (holding objects and playing with toys)
- speech and language development (understanding and communicating)
- self-help and personal-social development (doing things for self and getting along with others)
- vision and hearing
